Great Pinot Noir creates a lasting impression on the palate and in the memory. Its aroma is often one of the most complex of all varietals and can be intense with a ripe-grape or black cherry aroma, frequently accented by a pronounced spiciness that suggests cinnamon, saffron, or mint. The most appealing quality of Pinot Noir may be its soft, velvety texture.

malbec

Malbec is typically a medium to full bodied red wine. Ripe fruit flavors of plums and blackberry give it a jammy characteristic. The tannins are typically a bit tight and earthy, wood-like appeal makes for a fairly rustic, yet versatile wine

merlot

Merlot is the second most widely-planted black wine grape in the world. While its flavor profile is similar to Cabernet Sauvignon. Merlot tends to be less distinctive and slightly more herbaceous overall in both aroma and taste. Ripeness seems critical; both under ripe and overripe grapes lean away from fruit and towards herbaceousness. Merlot has slightly lower natural acidity than Cabernet and generally less astringency, therefore usually a lush mouth feel.

cabernet sauvignon

Cabs range from medium-bodied to full-bodied and are characterized by their high tannin content which serves to provide structure and intrigue while supporting the rich fruit characteristics. The flavor includes plum, cherry, blackberry, blueberry, warm spice, vanilla, tobacco and sometimes leather aromas

shiraz

Wines made from Shiraz are often powerfully flavored and full-bodied. The variety produces wines with a wide range of flavor notes, depending on the climate and soils where it is grown, as well as other viticulture practices chosen. Aroma characters can range from violets to berries (usually dark as opposed to red), chocolate, espresso and black pepper.

The reason for blending both Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot mainly (there are other red blend type as well) was that in the eyes of the French, or some winemaker, neither of these grapes was likely to produce a complete wine—the best wine possible. The addition of Merlot to a Cabernet Sauvignon for an instance, softens the wine.

However, almost every village in Spain produces its own wine, which is red, white, sparkling or sweet desert wine depending on the variety of grapes produced in each area.
